Out-of-hours emergency

Please pull the emergency pull cord by the door and give details of the emergency to the operator.

Wifi

You will find an oval plaque hung on the wall by the tv, which displays the Wifi login details

Kitchenette

The kitchenette is equipped with a fridge, microwave, sink and you will find an ironing board and iron in the tall cupboard.

Tea, coffee, sugar, milk and bottled water are provided complimentary. Please let us know if they need replenishing during your stay.

TV

A remote control is provided to turn the TV on/off and change channels.

Heating

You will find a thermostatic control on the left side of the radiator under the window.

Waste

Please place all food waste in the bin provided. The bin store is located on the ground floor - on the left, just past the office.



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Laundry

Before leaving, please place all used tea towels, bath towels and the shower mat in the laundry bag provided.

Payment

Please pay your bill in the office before you leave.

Check Out

Please return the keys to the office before you leave.

Unfortunately, there will be a £80 charge for any keys not returned.

If you leave outside office hours, please post the keys through the letterbox in the office door.

Please also let us know if anything is broken or not working.

Shower Room

The shower room is separate from the guest room but is for your exclusive use during your stay.

Please ensure you take the keys with you when using the shower room, so that you are not locked out of the guest room.

To operate the shower:

1. Turn the power on by pulling the cord located between the door and the shower enclosure.
2. Press the button on the shower to start the water.
Please be aware that the water is very hot at first, so caution should be taken.

Fire Procedure

Silverstone Court operates a "Stay Put" fire policy.

- If you hear the fire alarm while in the guest room and the fire is not in there, please remain in your room with the door closed.
- If the fire is in the guest room, leave immediately using the stairs to the left as you exit the room and proceed to the assembly point in the car park.
- Do not use the lift.

If you are in the communal areas and the fire alarm sounds, please leave the building immediately and go to the assembly point in the car park.

Pershore Road (A441) connects directly to Birmingham City Centre and south to Longbridge and Redditch.

Bus

Frequent services including 45 and 47 run to Birmingham City Centre, Selly Oak, Cotteridge, and Longbridge. Service 27 runs to Kings Heath.

Nearby stations include Pineapple Road, Kings Heath, Moseley Village, Kings Norton and Bournville, providing fast links to Birmingham New Street and beyond.
